THE BOATING COUNCIL SEEKS TO PROTECT AND IMPROVE THE MARINE ENVIRONMENT

- *currently supports* dredging of Northport Harbor to improve tidal flush and water quality of the Huntington Bay Complex.
- works with various levels of government and private agencies to insure our local waterways benefit from funding allocated under the Clean Water/Clean Air Bond Act.
- *represents membership* on the Northport Water Quality Committee to successfully upgrade the Northport Sewage Treatment Plant and reverse pollution in Northport Bay and surrounding waters.
- **supports** mobile pump out boats with extended hours and stations in the area harbors.
- **supported legislation** to ban the sale of products containing formaldehyde for use in holding tank treatments in the Town of Huntington.
